



Food Service Grease Trap Waste Permitted Transporters

The Texarkana Water Utilities has provided this list as a courtesy to the User and does not endorse nor recommend any transporter. A transporter must possess a valid Liquid Waste Transport Permit in order to clean a grease trap. The list contains the transporters with a current Permit issued by Texarkana Water Utilities to collect and transport food service grease trap waste in the territorial boundaries of the Cities of Texarkana, Nash and Wake Village.

Grease trap waste includes restaurant-type grease waste only. It is the generator's responsibility to solicit the services of transporters permitted for their particular type of waste. The transporter is required to leave one copy of the waste manifest with the generator prior to leaving the generator's site. The generator and transporter information will be completed on the first copy received by the generator at the time the waste was collected. ***Do not accept any manifest copy with the disposal information completed at the time the grease trap is cleaned.*** The transporter is also required to provide the generator with a completed copy of the manifest within fourteen (14) days after disposal of the waste. The "cradle-to-grave" rule holds the generator, as well as the transporter, liable in case of improper or illegal disposal.

The grease trap must be totally evacuated or emptied when cleaned. Grease remaining on walls and piping must be removed by scraping, pressure washing or other method. Local code prohibits the return of any solids or liquids to the trap.
